
Safety, Health and Environmental (SH&E) Policy

- Participate with governmental agencies, the public, interested groups and industry associations in the development of reasonable and risk-based scientifically sound laws, regulations and public policy.
- Seek public input and respond to stakeholder concerns about our products and operations.
- Provide our employees, and other stakeholders with appropriate information necessary for their understanding of, the environmental, health and safety aspects of our operations and products, our safety, health and environmental performance, and the contribution our products make to the quality of life.
